Role/Ministry	Can you describe what this person does?		
Readers	A person chosen or set apart to read Holy Scripture in the church service.	Sacristan	A person who takes care of the church's furniture and ensures that the linens are pressed and clean.
Priest	A person who administering the church's seven sacraments like baptism, confirmation, confession, holy communion, marriage, holy orders and anointing of the sick.	Collectors	A person who collects plates or baskets is often used during the offertory to gather the gifts of the faithful for the support.
Flower arranger	A person work of the arrangers speaks for itself. The role is give to beauty and decorate the church to the glory of God.	Extraordinary Ministers	A person who assists in the distribution of Holy Communion.
Greeters	A person that welcomes regular members and visitors with a smile, hug or handshake as they arrive in the door.
