


Let's start our lesson by lighting a candle together.

I wonder what they are being given...


I wonder how they are feeling...

Talk about why Catholics go to Mass.




Lots of families together make up one big family. We call this family the parish. Everyone is welcome and important.






Why is it special?

'Take this, all of you, and eat of it: For this is my body.'






'This is the chalice of my blood.'
'Do this in memory of me.'


During Mass, we go up to the priest with our arms crossed to receive a special blessing.

When we are older, we receive the bread and the wine. This is what Jesus did at *The Last Supper*.

This man is receiving the bread and wine.



This girl is receiving a special blessing.



After Mass some people like to stay and share time together. This is a time to get to know one another. Jesus asks us to love one another.

At the end of Mass, the priest or deacon says: 'Go in peace'.

We respond with: 'Thanks be to God'.


After Mass we go out and love one another, just as Jesus asked.




Task: Sequence the pictures on the following page to show the correct order of mass.

You can either print and stick them or you can draw your own. Write under each picture what is happening OR share your ideas verbally with an adult.


Challenge: Why is mass important for Christians?
