



## COVID-19 Catch-Up Funding Action Plan

**Total amount of funding: £24,679**

1<sup>st</sup> tranche (based on October 2019 census figures of 301 pupils @ £20 each) **£6,020**

2<sup>nd</sup> tranche (based on October 2020 census figures of 311 pupils @ £26.67 each) **£8,294**

3<sup>rd</sup> tranche (based on October 2020 census figures of 311 pupils @ £33.33 each) **£10,365**

Following the 2020 lockdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic, schools have received an additional amount of money to provide catch-up support for those pupils who have been most disadvantaged. In order to utilise this additional funding in the best possible way, we have carefully considered our pupil's academic and personal development needs to inform our decisions. The table below outlines our intentional spend to-date, with a rationale accompanying each decision.
